## CONSUMER FIREWORKS

CONSUMER FIREWORKS ARE INTENDED FOR RECREATIONAL USE BY THE PUBLIC



**No permit required** when used in accordance with the by-law.



May only be discharged on the days and during the hours permitted by the by-law.



Must be used on private property with the owner's permission.



User must follow all safety distances and manufacturer instructions.



Items like Roman candles, sparklers, fountains, volcanoes, and mines.



Cannot create a nuisance or endanger people or property.

## DISPLAY FIREWORKS

PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL FIREWORKS FOR EVENTS REQUIRING SPECIAL LICENSE



**Permit REQUIRED** from the North Stormont Fire Chief before any display.



May be held on approved dates and times as authorized in the permit.



May occur on public or private property with required approvals.



Must be supervised by a qualified fireworks supervisor and comply with all permit conditions.



Site plan, safety measures, and emergency access may be required as part of the permit approval.

## PERMIT REQUIRED?

 Family backyard fireworks using consumer fireworks on permitted dates	 <b>No</b>
 Neighbourhood fireworks show open to the public	 <b>Yes</b>
 Community event, festival, or Canada Day fireworks display	 <b>Yes</b>
 Professional fireworks company conducting a display	 <b>Yes</b>

## PLANNING A PUBLIC FIREWORKS DISPLAY?

A Fireworks Display Permit must be approved by the North Stormont Fire Chief before the event.

**BEFORE THE EVENT.**



Consumer fireworks may only be used as permitted under By-law 53-2025.



Failure to comply may result in enforcement action and fines.
