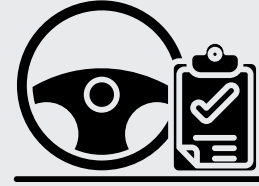

LICENSED IN ANOTHER PROVINCE, STATE OR COUNTRY



Direct Exchange

- A licence holder who has two or more years of driving experience in another province, state or exchangeable country may be able to exchange their licence without graduated waiting periods and practical testing.

**Driving Experience
Credit**

- Licence holders from all other jurisdictions must enter the graduated licence system. Driving credit may be applied to reduce waiting periods by up to 12 months.

NEVER LICENSED / NEW DRIVER



**Never Licensed /
New Driver**

- Drivers who have never held a licence must enter the graduated licence system.
- Over a minimum of 20 months, new drivers gain driving experience and are assessed with practical testing using a two-step process.

GRADUATED LICENSING



Ontario has a graduated licensing system. Drivers will need to complete a knowledge test and two road tests. Previous driving experience may be used to reduce the required wait times by up to 12 months.

KNOWLEDGE TESTING

We offer the knowledge test in the most popular languages our customers speak. Visit our website for details and languages offered at www.DriveTest.ca.

We also offer audio versions, and verbal testing with an approved interpreter. Credentials for interpreters must be provided and an appointment is required for verbal testing.



PREPARING FOR THE ROAD TEST

Prepare for your road test appointment by:

- Studying the Official MTO Handbook
- Ensuring your vehicle is in good working condition
- Having adequate highway experience (Class G test)
- Being prepared for driving directions or instructions
